Imagine a mother with two young children in a hopelessly violent relationship. In a moment of courage, she dials the WCA's 24-hour crisis hotline. The residential specialist who answers the phone listens to the mother as she describes her situation. At the end of the call, the mother has been given the knowledge about our shelter, court advocacy program, counseling and case management services, childcare and much more. Now flash forward two months. The mother and her two children are tucked in their beds, warm and safe in the WCA's emergency shelter. They are all in counseling, striving to heal from the wounds of domestic violence. Throughout the two months, the mother has met with a case manager and is on her way to obtain full-time employment. She has already had two interviews! But most importantly, this mother has learned about the cycle of violence and how to break free from it.
